

In The Matter of the Incorporation of the Town of Monroe.

Now to- wit:, on this 29th day of May 1901, the matter of confirming the incorporation of the South half of the South west quarter of Section Teh(10) and the North West Quarter of Section fifteen(15) Township 100 N. of Range 54 West of the 5th P.M. into the Town of Monroe, coming on regularly to be heard and it appearing to the satisfaction of this Board that an election of the qualified electors of said territory on May 13th 1901, a majority of the electors of said territory, voting at said election, voted in favor of the incorporation of said territory and a majority of the ballots cast were in favor of said incorporation and it further appearing that said election was in all respects legal, It is by this Borad, Ordered and Declared that said Town has been lagally incorporated as The Town of Monroe.
